English Language Arts: Continued

- This week we will continue with our classroom novel *James and the Giant Peach* (Chapters 19 to 21 and Chapter 22 to 24)
- More work on adjectives, adverbs and noun practice, which also includes properly capitalizing and writing on the lines
 - For example, adding adjectives to expand noun phrases
- Starting our first descriptive writing assignment, which includes writing using paragraphs, indenting, appealing to the five senses, and both peer and self-editing prior to submitting
