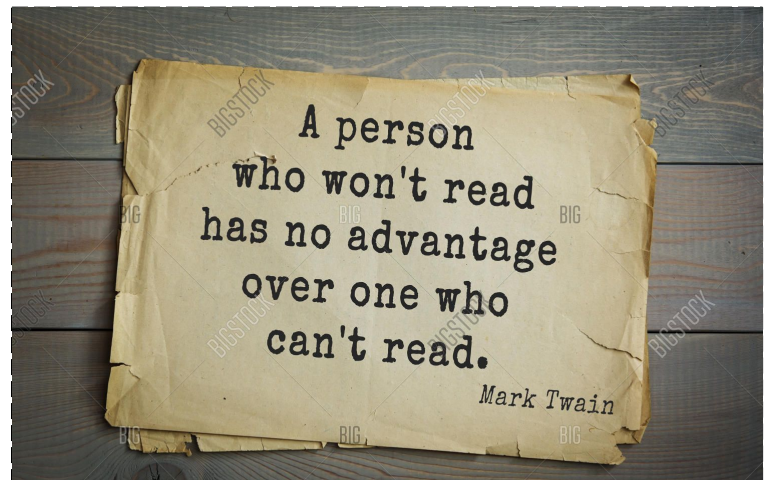

A Peek at what we are learning:

English Language Arts: Continued

- This week we will continue with our classroom novel *James and the Giant Peach* (Chapters 4 to 6 and Chapter 7 to 9)
- More work on adjectives, adverbs and noun practice, which also includes properly capitalizing and writing on the lines
 - For example, adding adjectives to expand noun phrases
- Starting our first descriptive writing assignment, which includes writing using paragraphs, indenting, appealing to the five senses, and both peer and self-editing prior to submitting
- Continue reading lessons on how to effectively summarize and also stop to check for understanding when reading

Mathematics:

- Dividing 2-digit numbers by 1-digit numbers.
- Division as the opposite of multiplication.
- Writing division and multiplication
