Respond to books/ texts: Sequencing and Retelling the story: Hare is Scared by Elizabeth Emende - Orienting book correctly, following direction in reading (left to right) **Vocabulary:** hare, monkey, elephant, monster, friends, helping, scared, cried, angry, sad, happy;

Math

- **Number Concepts and Operations:** Introduce number 5 by reading the book Numbers by Eric Carté. Use little lines and a curve to form the number; Show the number on ten-frames
- **Shapes:** Review "square" and **colour** – Introduce colour Yellow
- **Introduce** AB Pattern with colour or actions. Example: blue- yellow

Science

Scientific and Inquiry Skills: Children will learn about **trees** and discuss the focus question, **What do we know about trees?** They will listen to the story "A Grand Old Tree" **Vocabulary:** trunk, branch, leaf, roots, flower, fruit

Social Emotional
