Essential Supplies List for First Day of School for Your Child's Personal Use

Grades 1 –3

Dear Parent,

For the first day of school, each student is required to bring the following items with the amount only needed for their own personal use:

- 3 x tissue boxes (1 per term)
- reusable water bottle
- pencil case
- 2 x boxes of lead pencils (30 pieces)
- 3 x erasers
- 1 x scissors
- 6 x glue sticks
- 1 x ruler (grade 2 and 3 ONLY)
- 1 x small bottle of hand sanitizer for the child
- 1 x pack of colored pencils
- 1 x pack of colored markers
- 4 x whiteboard markers
- 1 x white board (30cm x 20cm)
- 1 x whiteboard eraser
- 3 x plastic envelope folders (green, orange, white/clear)
- 2 x A4 size notebooks
- 1 x A4 laminating film
- wired headphones with audio jack and microphone (required for tablet time)
- 1 x ring binder A4 display book (for student portfolio)
